Juna Ellsworth Griffiths, beloved wife, mother, sister, grandmother, and great-grandmother, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her family on December 16, 2021.

Juna was born December 21, 1942, in Mesa, Arizona and spent her youth in the farming community of Queen Creek, Arizona. She attended Queen Creek Elementary and graduated from Chandler High School in 1960. Soon after, she moved to Salt Lake City, Utah to attend college.
