



## Lowell Morris Sorensen

*March 19, 1919 ~ April 20, 2014*

Lowell Morris Sorensen, 95, of Salt Lake City, Utah died April 20, 2014. He was born March 19, 1919 in Salt Lake City, Utah, the son of Fred Alfred Sorensen and Mary Minerva Morris Sorensen.
