**Karen Lee Conrad Jaenisch**, age 82, returned to her Heavenly Father on January 6, 2026.

Karen was born on February 24, 1943, in Ogden, Utah, to Max E. and Emily Claire Conrad. The oldest of five children, she grew up in Fallon, Nevada, where she enjoyed participating in local 4-H clubs and attended Churchill County Schools.

Karen had three children she was very proud of: Bill, Carmen, and Mindy. In 1996, she married the love of her life, Klaus Jaenisch. They met at a church dance and were married on April 26, 1996, later having their marriage solemnized in the Salt Lake City Temple. They lived in West Valley City before moving to the East Millcreek area in 2005.

Karen was an active member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. She later served a mission with the Church Employment Division. Following her retirement in 2005, Karen and Klaus enjoyed traveling throughout the western United States, taking a memorable cruise to Alaska, and visiting Germany to meet Klaus's family. They later welcomed and hosted his family in the United States for several weeks. Karen was a member of the Garden Heights North Ward for 19 years and the Cougar Lane Ward the last few years.

Karen earned an Associate's Degree from Salt Lake Community College and worked for many years as a Credit Manager. She was an active member of the National Association of Credit Managers and the Credit Women's Group of Utah, serving on the boards of both organizations.
