LaNiel Gardner Reasch finished her turn on earth on January 2, 2024. Born to Brigham Delos and Camera Lorean Gardner on May 1, 1933, in Grover, Wyoming. She was the fourth of eight children.

After graduating from Star Valley High School in Afton Wyoming at age 17, she attended the University of Wyoming. She graduated with a degree in Secretarial Science. She was a teacher at the National College of Business. She taught both elementary and high school but her passion was teaching business to teenagers. Throughout her life she was an exemplary teacher of business and the gospel of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. While attending the University in Laramie she met and dated Joseph Rex Reasch. They were sealed for time and eternity on September 14, 1954, in the Salt Lake Temple.

She was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day-Saints. She served in many callings from gospel doctrine teacher, young women president, temple worker, and seminary teacher. Her passions in life were chocolate, Wyoming, family history extracting, knitting dish rags, and the Jazz. She loved visits and always offered visitors M&Ms as you left her home.

She is survived by daughters, Suzan Desotelle, Rhonda Hatch (Brent), Joleen Zimmer (Michael) and son, Larry (Bobbi) Reasch, 11 grandchildren and 23 great grandchildren, siblings Joel Gardner, Margorie Bradshaw and Vivian Jones.

She was preceded in death by her sweetheart Rex, baby, Cara Rae, mother, Camera Lorean, father, Delos Gardner, grandson, Josh Cotrell, in-laws Chasty Allred and Frank Reasch, brothers Delworth and Harold Gardner, sisters Nola Jean Leavitt and Julia Sarvey.
