Our loving mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, aunt and friend, Leah Fay Ferrin Evans, passed away peacefully at her home on May 28, 2023. She was born February 28, 1931, in Salt Lake City, Utah to John Josiah Ferrin and Pearl Leone Shaw Ferrin. She graduated from West High School and attended the University of Utah where she played clarinet in the marching band then worked for A.J. Elggren & Sons, a food brokerage firm, for 4 years until she started her family. She married Preston Davis Evans on August 30, 1960, in the Salt Lake Temple and they enjoyed 46 wonderful years together until his death on August 3, 2006.
