Lisa Martinez died peacefully at Alta View Hospital on December 29, 2021 in Sandy, UT after a brief battle with breast cancer.

Lisa was a generous and witty individual who gathered multiple friends about her. She enjoyed reading about history. She loved gardening, attending theatre, travel, and her cats. She was devoted to Jack's children and grandchildren. She frequently cared for loved ones as needed.

Lisa is survived by her son Chris (Megan) and granddaughter Samantha Emileigh Otteson; by her mother Beverly, her brother Mark Elkington (Kim Stauss), nephews Eric Elkington, Dylan Elkington-Stauss and Caleb Elkington-Stauss.
