Marcia Dumas Fabian passed away at the age of 91 on May 23, 2025, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

She was born to Lawrence Alexander Dumas and Ethalyn Milaney Dumas on June 29, 1933, in Duluth, Minnesota. Raised in Des Moines, Iowa and a graduate of Roosevelt High School, Marcia attended Colorado University where she graduated with a BA in Political Science.
