Marcia Gardiner, 68, passed away quietly in her sleep on March 16, 2022 from complications due to cardiomyopathy.

Born March 11, 1954, the youngest of ten children to Harold Birk and Erma Young Gardiner in Salt Lake City where she spent childhood days playing sandlot baseball with the neighborhood boys in Logan Circle.
