*March 12, 1967 ~ July 26, 2022*

Margaret Little, age 55, passed away July 26, 2022 at Avalon Woodland Park Care Center in Millcreek. Utah. Perhaps she wanted to go hike Ensign Peak for the anniversary. She wasn't one to be on time, she didn't see the need in it, but she did that day getting up before 5pm the only way she could. Her heart stopped beating.

Margaret was born March 12, 1967, at the LDS Hospital in Salt Lake City to Neils Clove and Margaret Ruth Phelps Little.

Margaret loved talking to people. That was her hobby. She also loved her turkey and cheese sandwich and yogurt before bed. She loved to hug children. She said if they didn't need a hug, then their hug-o-meter was full. A lot of people at Avalon Woodland Park Care will miss her very much. She won an election as President of the Resident Council without even campaigning. People knew she would help them. Once coming back from the hospital, she had a lady waiting till she was settled to help her with a problem.

Margaret graduated from South High School in Salt Lake City in 1985 where she was in the Key Club, orchestra and sang Acapella. She went to the Senior Prom with friend Lance Langton. She graduated from LDS Business College with an associate degree in Medical Assisting. She went to help a neighbor who needed help and a lady working with her suggested she become a Certified Nurses Nursing Assistant (CNA). She went to Salt Lake Community College. She worked for Applegate Home Health Care. She worked there 13 years before she got a really bad case of lymphedema. She went to Woodland Park Care Center and was there eight and a half years. She almost died twice of Acute Respiratory Failure.

She is survived by many who've loved her including: her sister Marlene Little, and lots of cousins, multitudes of friends and adopted family. She was preceded in death by her parents and her friend Andy Eugene Osborne at Woodland Park.
