In Chicago Marie worked for Continental Airlines and after raising their family Marie and Elmer lived in Hawaii where Marie worked for Mid Pacific Air. They moved to Phoenix in 1990 where Marie worked for America West Airlines. After the death of Elmer in 2013 Marie moved to Salt Lake City where she enjoyed her life in Park Lane Senior Living Center and Nancy oversaw her care. Marie was proud of her Irish heritage and was a devout Roman Catholic. She received last rites from Monsignor Joseph Mayo and was greeted by the angels when she passed.
