



## Mary Beckstead Rindlisbacher Jensen

Mary Beckstead Rindlisbacher Jensen, age 83, passed away peacefully surrounded by her children on August 3rd, 2023, in South Jordan, UT, after struggling with dementia.

She was born July 22nd, 1940, in Murray, UT., daughter of Edward B. and Mary Ellen Beckstead. After four sons, she was the light of her parents' lives. Mary also enjoyed walking and walked nearly every day for 40 years.

After losing Hal in 2002, she met Bruce Jensen, and they married on June 18th, 2005. She moved with Bruce to Vista, CA where they managed a senior living community. Here Mary made many friends and loved staying busy with activities.
