Most of her nursing career was spent at St. Francis Medical Center in Trenton, NJ and she later worked for Capital Health System in Trenton. Marie was particularly proud of her work as a Health Educator providing education and awareness to women about breast cancer and her many years in Occupational Health. She loved being a nurse. This defined much of her life and she was quick to inform all her caregivers of her extensive nursing background! She also served as the go-to person for family and neighbors regarding all manner of illnesses and injuries. Marie was married to Philip Asbrand in 1960 and later divorced. She was a devoted and loving mother to her son James and met the many challenges of being a single parent head on with help from family and friends. later in life.
