On August 23, 2022, Ray passed away unexpectedly at his home in Riverton surrounded by his loved ones.

Ray was born July 27, 1943 in Alton, IL to Wilbert Calvin Bolen and Fern Elizabeth Stolze Bolen. He was the oldest of 3 children. Ray spent his younger years in IL before the family relocated to the Seattle, WA area.

Ray graduated from Renton High School in 1961 in Washington, and joined the Army shortly thereafter. During his time in the Army Ray was stationed at various bases one of which was Fort Douglas in SLC. This is where Ray met his wife, Linda. They were married in Las Vegas, NV in 1965.
