He was President of the Utah Dental Association and was beloved by all his patients.

Neal married Marilyn Van Horn, the light of his life, in 1978 and instantly expanded the size of his extended family. He supported his family in all their endeavors, including attending soccer, basketball, football, and baseball games. He loved life and was an enthusiastic supporter and organizer of family events, reunions, and other social activities. He was an avid skier and skied with family and friends well into his 80's. Neal lived a good life and was the absolute example of a good man.
