Our husband, dad, grandpa and great-grandpa, Niel E Cowles, 73, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, June 5, 2021. He was born September 15, 1947 to Alton Cowles and Audrey Halstead Moss. He grew up in Salt Lake City, UT, graduated from South High School and proudly served in the West Spanish American mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Niel battled serious health issues for more than 20 years and never complained. He never let them get in the way of participating in family functions, outings or events. He loved to be with his family more than anything. He was known for his dad jokes and, after losing his sight, his blind jokes. He always turned difficult things into a positive, happy experience.
