She was raised in Salt Lake City where she enjoyed dance, cheerleading, violin, a cappella choir, and theater at East High School. She relished her time at the University of Utah as a songleader, Chi Omega sister, and Homecoming Queen. She graduated with honors in 1965, after being crowned Miss Utah.

In 1966, she married her high school sweetheart, Bill Lloyd, in the Salt Lake Temple. Theirs is an eternal love story that began in their teens. They enjoyed 43 years together before Bill passed away after an 8-year battle with cancer. Bonnie tirelessly supported and cared for him, every step of the way.
