On July 3, 2025, Orson Keith Matthews, our beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, great-great grandfather, brother, and friend, passed away in Sandy, Utah at the wonderful age of 90.

Orson Keith Matthews was born September 10, 1934, in South Gate, CA the second of four children, to Charles Orson and Lorana (Owens) Matthews. Keith lived life to the fullest; offering a smile and a greeting to everyone who crossed his path. He had many wonderful memories from his time growing up in Southern California. He loved sports, particularly basketball and baseball. He graduated from South Gate High School in 1952. Following a two-year courtship, Keith married his sweetheart, Barbara Grace Neese in the St. George, Utah temple on June 28, 1955.
