Owen was born with beautiful auburn hair, a perfect blend of his mom and dad. He had the cutest button nose. His darling blond eyebrows and eyelashes remind us of his dad. He was measuring ahead of schedule at each prenatal appointment and was born a whopping 8 pounds, 14 ounces. He was 21 inches long.

Although Owen was with us for only a few short hours before returning to his Heavenly Father, his parents felt they got to know him well during their 9-month pregnancy. He loved when Mom and Dad would read books to him.

Whenever his dad got home from work and hugged his mom, he would kick Dad. His parents frequently found themselves smiling, as his cute personality showed brightly, well before they got to see him in person. He was a night owl, like his dad, always kicking and moving around late into the night, when mom preferred to be sleeping.

A private graveside service for family will be held for Owen at the Salt Lake City Cemetery at 11:00am on Saturday, February 26, 2022. The services will be streamed via Zoom through Larkin Mortuary for the many friends and family who would like to attend virtually.
