Randy was a natural athlete and participated in football, wrestling, and track. He was an Eagle Scout and an avid outdoorsman. He was devoted to his LDS faith, serving a mission in the Washington Tacoma Mission and currently serving as the Bishop of his ward. Randy attended Utah Valley University. Randy married Kristin Camilla Gillette on June 19, 2004, in the Manti, UT LDS temple. Together they have three beautiful children, Asher Omni, Sarah Pearl, and baby girl.
