



## Paul Milwood Halliday

Paul Milwood Halliday, our loving patriarch, father, grandfather, and great grandfather passed away on September 9, 2022 at his home at the age of 94. Paul was born February 7, 1928 in Salt Lake City, Utah to Camille Woodbury Halliday and Herbert Hartland Halliday. In 1945 Paul met Rosie Kink while both were working at the Salt Lake Tribune and were married June 18, 1949. Marriage was later solemnized in the Salt Lake Temple in 1965. Paul led an extraordinary and fulfilling life.

He had many adventures living with his brothers, Herb, Dean, Tom, and sister, Ann at 779 4th Avenue. At age 18 Paul received his pilot license enjoying each moment of flying high in the sky.

Paul graduated from East High School in 1945. He enlisted in the Air National Guard. He was activated during the Korean War, stationed at the air base in Clovis, New Mexico. He received his law degree in 1951 from the University of Utah and practiced law with his father, brother, son, and grandson for over 70 years; blessed to be working and associating with his many friends in the law office through the year 2022.

Paul loved the outdoors, especially Yellowstone, fishing its many streams and rivers with family members. Backpacking in the Uintah mountains with each child and then each grandchild - cherished memories. Family was most important to Paul and building relationships with each child and grandchild, which included riding in his motor home to Lake Powell and other places, Fourth of July family reunions at his condo in Park City, skiing, boating, hiking, hunting, and golfing.

Paul was a faithful member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. His testimony was strengthened while serving for 14 years in the Salt Lake Temple. He served in various capacities throughout his life which included a service mission in the inner city of Salt Lake, bishopric, scouting, and teaching.
