Paul Ronald Peay passed away March 6, 2025. He was born November 5th, 1943 in Provo, Utah, to Paul Duke and Eileen Jex Peay. Ron was blessed with one sister, Roberta, with whom he shared two short years of life. Ron lived in Utah all his life, settling in Davis County where he graduated from Bountiful High school in 1962.

Ron spent 37 years as a beloved educator in the Jordan and Canyon school districts, where he made a lasting impact on his students. Most of his teaching career was spent in elementary education, where he had a unique ability to connect with students. Ron loved music, and in addition to his time in the classroom, he spent many hours leading children's choirs and showcasing his talents and love of music.

Ron passed away peacefully on March 6th, surrounded by his loving family. He is survived by his wife Kirsten, his six children Brandon (Greta), Eliisa (Jeremy) Butler, Jeffrey (Trystal), Andy (Jessica), Jon (Tori), and Michael (Jade); 21 grandchildren, and 4 great-grandchildren.
