She loved being outside "puttering" around her garden. She spent many hours in the spring and summer months in her yard, making sure everything looked just right. Her home was always filled with love and kindness. She was an enthusiastic baker and loved having people over to entertain. She loved Sunday dinners with her family. She loved disco music and could be found dancing around the room whenever her favorite tunes came on. She loved shopping with "her girls".

Paula loved spending time with her family, friends, and cousins. Their support of her in the last 17 months showed their love for her, and her memory will live on in their hearts.

Paula was preceded in death by her parents and her brother Jeffrey (Jenn) Anderson. She was survived by her children and sister, Jeanine (Peter) Hanson, her aunt Brenda Anderson, many nieces and nephews, brother-in-law Matt Peacock, and many cousins.
