Phil C Gerhart passed away surrounded by his family on May 23, 2022 at the age of 82. Phil was born and raised in Great Falls, Montana.

He served in the Switzerland-Austria Mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints from 1959 to 1961. He attended BYU and earned his bachelor's and master's degrees in civil engineering and remained a lifelong Cougar fan. Phil also proudly served in the Army National Guard from 1962 to 1971.
