Phyllis Rae Lake Stoddard was born January 8, 1937 to Phillip Ray Lake and Myrle Walton in Alpine, Wyoming. She passed away peacefully September 12, 2022 at the age of 85, after suffering for two years with dementia. She was under the care of Inspiration Hospice at St. Joseph's Villa in Salt Lake City.

She was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. She was married four times: Kenneth W. Bush in 1954, to whom their son Kenneth W. Bush Jr. was born. They were later divorced. She married Lou Ostovich in 1960; they had one son, Paul. They later divorced. In 1963 she married Earl Stoddard and they had one daughter, Kristi. They later divorced. Phyllis married Hollis Sargent in 1987 and they divorced in 1994. Phyllis received her honorary 1955 high school diploma from Idaho Falls High School when she turned 84, a very kind gesture of the district 91 superintendent. She earned her cosmetology credentials from the Vogue Beauty Salon in 1962. She had a quick wit and was always elegant in her appearance.
