Don passed away on February 23, 2018 at the age of 94. He was born October 1, 1923 in Bingham Canyon, Utah to E. Clinton Poulsen and Emma Vida Knudsen. He is a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, where he served as Bishop, Bishopric member and on the Midvale Stake High Council. Don proudly served his country in the Army for three years during WWII in China and Africa. He was a loyal Bingham Miner and still sang the fight song when Bingham played. He spoke of their football team with pride and one of his favorite sayings was "to get to the state finals they all have to go through Bingham".

Don is survived by his daughters Penny (Allen) Watson, Patsy Halladay, Emily (Brady) Bartholomew and Sharon Smith Poulsen, 17 grandchildren and 37 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, son James Donald "JD", parents, two brothers, Clinton Jack and Kenneth R. and sister, Vida Rae Russell.
