



## Rebecca Bennett Gadd

Rebecca Bennett Gadd passed away on April 9<sup>th</sup> 2026 after a long illness.

The daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Jack B. Bennett, Rebecca was delivered by her father on August 9<sup>th</sup> 1952 in Evanston, Wyoming.

After graduating from Evanston High, Rebecca attended the University of Utah from 1970 to 1973. While at the University, she wanted to become a Paleontologist but that dream was squelched when her father informed her she would have to sit for hours in hot climates doing tedious work. She hated heat and was always a person of action so that nixed that dream. Instead, she moved on to Westminster College and changed her major to get a BS in nursing, graduating Magna Cum Laude.

Rebecca was preceded in death by her parents, Dr. J.B. Bennett and Darlene Bennett and husband James Copeland.
