



## Robert Dal Marx

We announce with deep sorrow yet with a profound appreciation for a life richly lived, the passing of Robert Dal Marx on October 26, 2023, in Quartzsite, Arizona, at the age of 82. Born on September 10, 1941, in Gunnison, Utah, Robert was the youngest child of Ervin Edgar Marx and Edna Anderson Marx.
