She also volunteered at First Presbyterian Church and Salt Lake Christian Center in the early 1990's. She loved to dance as well and belly danced in her youth. She had a wonderfully warm and loving smile, infectious laugh and often sarcastic sense of humor. She also had an endless amount of patience and a knack for teaching. She was always happy to share her knowledge of knitting, photography, cooking, sewing or any of her skills with others.
