



## Russell Johnson

*June 13, 1947 ~ April 9, 2023*

Jay Russell Johnson, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and teacher, passed away Sunday April 9th, 2023 at the age of 75. He was born on June 13th, 1947 to loving parents Geraldine and Raymond Johnson, and grew up in Ogden, Utah.

He was a proud graduate of Ben Lomond High School in 1965. After high school, Russell went on to earn his degree from Brigham Young University. He was extremely proud of his school and could often be found cheering on BYU's football and basketball teams.

After graduating from Brigham Young, Russell married Cheryl Jean Satterthwaite on June 18th, 1976, in the Ogden Temple, where they were sealed for time and all eternity. Together they had four children: Sarah (Jake) Schaugaard, Blake (Jeri) Johnson, Todd (Cara) Johnson, and Ashlee (Chase) Dimond. He made countless friends during this time, and was a role model and mentor to many. Russell loved Disney, especially Mickey Mouse, and worked at Disney World after retiring in 2002. He enjoyed traveling with his family and students, especially to Disney Land and New York City. In addition to teaching, Russell was a master sergeant in the Army Reserves and proudly served his country. Russell was also a skilled barber and enjoyed giving haircuts to family and friends.

Russell was a devoted member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and served a mission in Scotland from 1966-1968, where he developed a love for the Scottish people and culture. He served in the conference center, and as a temple worker at the Jordan River and Draper Utah Temples. He was also a director of the Hill Cumorah Pageant, where he combined his love of the church with his love for theater.

Russell had been struggling with dementia and diabetes in his later years, and despite receiving exceptional care from his family, his health had been gradually declining. He ultimately passed away peacefully in his home, surrounded by his loved ones. Russell was preceded in death by his wife, Cheryl Johnson, and his parents, Raymond and Geraldine Johnson. He is survived by his children, grandchildren, and siblings Radene Johnson, Dee (Kris) Johnson, and Dale (Cathy) Johnson.
