



## Ruth Ann Clinger Menten

*August 24, 1938 ~ December 7, 2022*

Ann Clinger Menten passed away peacefully in her sleep Wednesday December 7th, 2022. She was born August 24, 1938 to Dr. Wallace M. Clinger and Ruth Cloward Clinger in Salt Lake City, Utah. As the eldest of six children in the Clinger home, she set an example of reading books, diligently practicing musical instruments, developing good study habits and socializing with friends.

She attended East High School from 1954 to 1956 and the University of Utah from 1956 to 1960. She was affiliated with Alpha Chi Omega sorority where she cultivated lifelong friends. She served as Panhellenic president at the U of U from 1959 to 1960 and graduated with a BS in Education. Her grandparents, Dr. Ralph E. and Betty Cloward, encouraged further postgraduate education; in 1961 she completed a Masters in Special Education at Columbia University, New York City. Upon graduation, she taught school at the USAF base in Itazuki, Japan for several years. In 1964, she accepted another assignment with the USAF to teach in Bremerhaven, Germany. Ann returned stateside in 1965 to teach elementary school in the San Bruno and Cupertino school districts in the Bay Area. She met her husband, Robert Martin Menten in 1968, married in 1969 and settled in Los Altos, CA for the next 30 years. Their two sons, Michael and Russell, were their pride and joy.

Ann returned to her Salt Lake City roots in 1998. She enjoyed her retirement years with dear friends, activities with the Utah Symphony Guild, attended University of Utah OSHA classes and traveled throughout the United States, Russia, England, China, Australia and India. Ann was a passionate traveler and an ardent student of world history and affairs. She was never seen without a book, newspaper or notebooks throughout her life.

Ann is survived by her 2 sons, Michael Gorham (Tracy) of Salt Lake City, Utah and Rusty Menten (Amy) of Sutherlin, Oregon, Rebekah C.
