Sarah will be remembered for her soft voice, kind heart, fiery red hair, and gifted artistic talent. Sarah's life leaves her many friends and family celebrating and admiring how strong, positive, and brave she was. Her kindness, love, and joyful outlook on life - despite many challenges - was universally admired by her family. She was quick to meet people where they were at in their lives with compassion and understanding.

Sarah grew up in Idaho and lived briefly in California and Montana before settling in Utah, where she met the love of her life, Austin. The last thing she did as she was being prepped for high-risk delivery in the delivery room was to give a gift to her surgeon - chocolates and a card - because, as she told him, "Doctors don't get thanked enough." Her last words were to Theo and Austin a brief moment after Theo's birth - they were "I love you."

She will be missed by all who knew and loved her. Theo will grow up hearing stories of his mother, who is watching over him with the same loving kindness that touched so many.
