Sharilee (Shari) Brower our sweet beloved Mother, Grandmother, Great-Grandmother, Sister, Aunt, and Friend transitioned into the next life on October 5, 2021, in South Jordan, Utah after a long courageous battle with Parkinson's disease.

Shari was born March 28, 1946, in her grandparents' home in Preston, Idaho to Samuel Thane and Wilda Manning Brower. They lived at the family ranch in Weston Idaho and later moved to Preston then subsequently Deweyville. The family later moved to Salt Lake City, Utah where she attended Sherman Elementary, Evergreen Junior High, and Skyline High School where she graduated in 1964. Later in life, she attended Westminster College. While attending Evergreen Jr High, she won first place in a school district-wide typing contest.

Shari married Jim Holt in 1964 and later divorced in 1980, together they had their three children. Shari remarried in 1984 and later divorced.

Shari worked for the State of Utah, Department of Business Regulation, Division of Public Utilities from approximately 1970 until 1982, and then worked for the US Postal Service, Purchasing Division in Utah, Alaska, and Colorado until she retired in August of 2002 and moved back to Utah a few years later.

Shari loved playing piano and the accordion, gardening, cooking, attending family reunions, jazzercise, camping, boating, waterskiing, and cleaning. Her house was immaculate and organized. Mom was a classy woman and always dressed the nines. When she lived outside of Utah, she traveled back home often for birthdays, holidays, and to spend time with her family. Her greatest joy later in life were her grandchildren.

Shari was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints she taught relief society, primary and young women where she chaperoned the youth on a Nauvoo Illinois trip.

When Shari's disease advanced and she needed more care, she moved into Sunridge Assisted Living in West Jordan, Utah then later moved to the Sheridan of South Jordan, and the last couple of months of her life were at

Pheasant Run Memory Care in South Jordan, Utah.

The family would like to give a special thanks to Trina Anderson who cared for mom during the first 3 years in assisted living, first at Sunridge and later at The Sheridan of South Jordan. Trina was by mom's side during some very difficult times, held her hand and loved her, and made her feel safe when the family was not there. We also give a special thank you to all of the other staff who cared for mom. She knew all your names and loved joking around with you, teasing you, and making smart comments. She especially liked flirting with the guys who cared for her.
