Sharon Lone Winn Glasgow passed on January 7, 2023, in Bountiful, Utah, at the age of 83. She was born on January 19, 1939, to Alma and Lone Winn in Salt Lake City, Utah. Sharon graduated from West High School in 1957 where she made lifelong friends and touched many lives. In 1963 she was crowned "Miss Handicapped America." She was the first disabled member of the Architectural Barrier's Committee of Salt Lake City, where she paved the way for better accessibility for the disabled community. She was chairman of the "March of Dimes" telethon, raising funds to improve the overall health of mothers and babies. Sharon volunteered at the University of Utah Hospital, as a mentor to patients who suffered from spinal cord injuries. She worked for L3 Communications and retired after 30 years as a Senior Buyer. She had a passion for all animals, especially her four-legged furry friends who called her "Gammy."

Impressive resume aside, Sharon will be most remembered for her radiant personality, her fierce character and especially her kind hearted and generous soul. She instilled in us a sense of tradition, of caring for those less fortunate than ourselves and always living unapologetically. She gave us fond memories of scary movies on weekend nights, and filled our days with happiness and adventure. She leaves us with abundant love in our hearts and gratitude for every single day we had with her.
