Sherrie Lee Bean Thomas passed away on March 8, 2021 at the age of 77 after a long battle with Inclusion Body Myositis. She was born to Glenn and Wilma Bean on March 22, 1943 in Santa Monica, CA. Her family later moved to Rexburg, ID where she spent the rest of her youth. She was highly involved in various clubs at Madison High School and was liked by all.

These qualities were a perfect match as she received her degree as a Registered Nurse at Ricks College where she was President of the Idaho State Student Nurses Association as well as Miss Ricks College in 1963.
