Terry Fred Hansen, a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 26, 2026, held in the loving arms of his wife. He was born on September 2, 1935, in Salt Lake City, Utah, to Henry Fred Hansen and Constance Elizabeth Wells Hansen. Terry grew up with his younger sisters, Peggy and Lola.

He was also active in his community and served as president of the Kiwanis Club. Terry had a generous spirit and was always among the first to offer help.
