Thelma Jeanette Parry passed away at the age of 85 on November 12, 2025 after a courageous battle with Parkinson's disease. Thelma was born on April 19, 1940 to Robert L. Cottle and Nona T. She was also a faithful supporter of her grandchildren in sports and other activities they were involved in.

Thelma always had a love for music, particularly singing. She was a member of school choirs and was also in a quartet and trio and sang with friends at various church functions. Thelma was also the chorister in Primary for many years as a member of the LDS church.

Thelma had a great love for animals her entire life. She had her own horse, Smoky, as a child. She was passionate about dogs, particularly dachshunds. For the last several years she had a chihuahua-dachshund mix named Tory. Tory was Thelma's shadow. Fittingly, Tory was by her side when she passed away.
