



## Tommy Joe Rohovit

*March 19, 1936 ~ May 8, 2024*

Tommy Joe Rohovit “Mr. Fantastic” of West Jordan, Utah, loving husband, father, grandfather, and basketball enthusiast, passed away peacefully on May 8, 2024, with his wife and youngest son by his side, at the age of 88.

Tom was born in Jefferson, Iowa, on March 19, 1936, to Clarence Kenneth (Ikey) Rohovit and Mildred Nelson Rohovit. He graduated from Jefferson High School in 1954, where he was a multi-sport athlete. He lettered in track, football, and basketball. He attended the University of Iowa where he played basketball in the 1954 NCAA Championship.
