Trudy Tucker Stokes Bullett quietly passed on March 15, 2026 from cancer. She was not in pain and was surrounded by loved ones. She is preceded in death by her first husband Roger Kent Cash Stokes, two grandsons—Jordan and Austin Stokes (Scot), and her siblings—Bob Tucker and Diane O'Brien. She met Mike Bullett at the Draper Senior Center and married him on March 29, 2019. Her and Mike loved to drive, cheer on the Utes, fight over politics and play poker with their friends each week.
