Van Richard Johnson joined his loving wife, Barbara, peacefully while sleeping on June 2nd, 2023.

While Van had accomplished great things and helped many during his life, most will remember Van for his clever wit, inviting smile and kindness towards others.

Born to Dorian and Fern Johnson on Sept 18th 1944, Van grew up gifted physically and intellectually achieving recognitions in both sports and academics. These traits served him well in supporting his mother, sister and two brothers when, at the age of 16, his father passed away.

Having grown up a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Van was called at age 19, and willingly served a 2 ½ year mission in Norway, a unique blessing as his father had served in the same mission. Van graduated from Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah where he met his eternal companion, Barbara Ann Gray. They were sealed for time and eternity in Idaho Falls on Aug 30th, 1967.

Van's education, career, and service pursuits provided him and Barbara the opportunity to live in, see, and serve in many parts of the U.S. and various parts of the World. After settling in California, Van was promoted to the position of President and CEO of Sutter Health, a role he considered an honor and a privilege. While living in California, Van and Barbara suffered the devastating loss of their youngest daughter, Alisha Johnson.
