Our wonderful father, grandfather and great-grandfather, Orval Ivan Wilson, 95, passed away Saturday, December 7, 2013. Born Oct 7, 1918 in Payson, UT, the 2nd child of Ivan Henry and Agnes Steiner Wilson. He married his high school sweetheart, Margaret Carlisle on June 21, 1939 in the Salt Lake LDS Temple. They were together for 70 years until her passing in June 2009. He worked at Lockheed Aircraft in Burbank, CA for 3 years before proudly serving his country in the Army's 7th Mechanized Cavalry Reconnaissance Troop, Asia/Pacific Campaign from 1943-1946.
